How did my child get his/her grade?

For the most part, the 4 point scale is used to grade your child's achievements and effort on all subjects, behavior, and social habits.

4 = 90-100%

3 = 70-89%

2 = 60-69%

1 = 59 and below

What is the homework for Language Arts?

- Your child is required to **read a book at their level daily at home for at least 30 minutes** and log in their **Reading Log**. Your child have to **use post-its** when he/she "stop and jot" his/her thoughts regarding a book's plot (setting, character, problem, solution), big ideas (theme), or questions and predictions he/she might have. He/she can also "stop and sketch" his/her thoughts using captions and labels to explain his/her thinking. These post-its will be **transferred to the Reader's Notebook once they finished reading the book**. I also suggest having your child use a timer. If you're child is reading the right leveled book, he/she should be reading 1 page per minute and would be able to tell you what he/she has read using at least 3 details in sequence.

What is the homework for Social Studies?

- There is a **project** due every 12 weeks. This project is based on your child's interest that is within the theme we are currently working on. The presentation can be on a poster, a cd if it's a video, acting, or a demonstration. Please check your child's **Projects Notebook** to see what he/she is working on.

How can I help my child at home?

- Check your child's Homework Folder** for communication from me or the school.
- Use the **TRC Comprehension Question Stems** after your child reads a book to you.
- Visit the ASGE school website** for school wide activities and deadlines such as the Globe Trotter, Words Wizards, and Facts Masters www.asge-laUSD-ca.schoolloop.com and click "For Students" or "For Parents" for recommended activities.
